1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

1.1 A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers, that is stored on your computer or other device when websites are loaded in a browser. They are widely used to “remember” you and your preferences.

A cookie is a simple computer file made of text. This information is used to personalise the experience of using the website nlaw.co.

1.2 They ensure a consistent and efficient experience for visitors, and perform essential functions such as allowing users to register and remain logged in. Cookies may be set by the site that you are visiting (known as “**first party cookies**”), or by third parties, such as those who serve content or provide advertising or analytics services on the website (“**third party cookies**”).

Cookies do a lot of different jobs which make your experience on the website nlaw.co much smoother and more interactive.

2. WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?

2.1 **Non-essential.** These cookies are non-essential for the website nlaw.co to work.

2.2 **Analytical or performance cookies.** Performance cookies collect information on how users interact with the website

nlaw.co. We use these details to improve how the website nlaw.co functions and to understand how users interact with it.

2.3 **Functionality cookies.** These cookies are used to store preferences set by users such as account name, language, and location.

2.4 **Security cookies.** We use these cookies to help identify and prevent potential security risks.

2.5 **Cookies we use:**

3. **HOW CAN YOU MANAGE COOKIES?**

3.1 **Removing cookies from your device.** You can delete all cookies that are already on your device by clearing the browsing history of your browser. This will remove all cookies from all websites you have visited. This way you may also lose some saved information (e.g. saved login details, site preferences).

3.2 **Turn on-off cookies.** You can turn the cookies 'On' or 'Off by changing the settings on your browser', then saving it. You may need to refresh your page for your settings to take effect.

3.3 **Rejecting cookies.** You can choose to reject or block all cookies set by the website nlaw.co. Please note that most browsers automatically accept cookies. Therefore, if you do not wish cookies to be used, you may need to actively delete or block the cookies. If you reject the use of cookies, you will still be able to use the website nlaw.co but some of the functions may not work correctly.
